ACORUS

VARIEGATED SWEET FLAG / ACORE

*Acorus calamus 'Variegatus'*

 Shape: Clumping Foliage: Green/Cream

Defined by its green and cream striped foliage and curious flower heads, this grass does best in wet, marshy areas or shallow ponds. Gives off a sweet scent if disturbed.

ANDROPOGON

BIG BLUE STEM

*Andropogon gerardii*

One of the major tall prairie grasses with foliage that turns from blue-green to silver-blue and then vibrant reds and oranges in the fall. This grass is drought tolerant and thrives in both heavy and sandy soils.

LITTLE BLUE STEM / SCHIZACHYRIUM À BALAIS

*Andropogon scoparius / Schizachyrium scoparium*

Deeply rooted and drought tolerant, this grass features finely textured blue-green foliage that turns a brilliant red-orange in the fall. Silvery seedheads are very showy and persist throughout the winter.

PRAIRIE BLUES LITTLE BLUE STEM / SCHIZACHYRIUM À BALAIS 'PRAIRIE BLUES'

A very decorative grass that produces thin, silver-blue blades of foliage that form a tight upright clump. In the fall, foliage becomes bright reddish-orange and fluffy silver seed heads are produced.

BOUTELOUA

SIDEOATS GRAMA / PIED DE DINDON

A turf-like grass that is great for massing, borders, or erosion control. Green foliage turns reddish-white in the fall and produces brown seed pods that hang towards one side of the plant.

An erect, narrowly columnar form that is ideal for accent or background plantings. Rosy-yellow plumes bloom from June to October.

AVALANCHE FEATHER REED GRASS / CALAMAGROSTIDE AVALANCHE

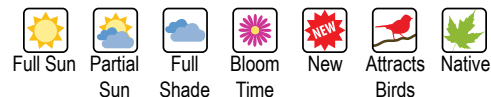

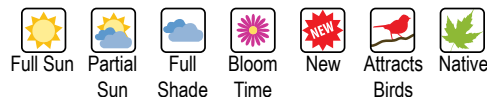
